The UNC Eshelman School of Pharmacy, in cooperation with GlaxoSmithKline and Quintiles, sponsors two-year fellowships in clinical pharmacokinetics (PK)/ pharmacodynamics (PD).

Fellows spend the first year of appointment participating in clinical pharmacokinetic, pharmacodynamic, transport, and/or metabolism studies at the UNC Eshelman School of Pharmacy. The second fellowship year will be spent with members of the Clinical Pharmacology group at Quintiles or with the Clinical Pharmacokinetics, Modeling and Simulation group at GlaxoSmithKline.

Ideal applicants will hold a PharmD, PhD, or MD. Advanced training/experience in pharmacokinetics and/or modeling simulation is preferred. Applications are due January 1, 2012, and appointments begin July 1, 2012. See our website for more on requirements and application.
