## **Medication Management:**

## Implications for Practices in CMS' Merit-Based Incentive Payment System (MIPS)

Did You Know?

More than half of Americans have at least one chronic condition, and 1 in 4 have two or more. Treating people with chronic conditions accounts for 86% of healthcare spending<sup>1</sup>

Only 33-50% of people with chronic conditions adhere completely to prescribed medication therapies<sup>2</sup> Nearly 1 in 3 adverse events leading to hospitalizations are associated with medications<sup>2</sup>

- >\$400 Billion is spent on medications in the U.S. each year<sup>3</sup>
- ~\$300 Billion is spent on the misuse, underuse & overuse of medications<sup>4</sup>



CMS' Quality Payment Program (QPP) provides practices the means and incentive to provide their patients high-value, high-quality, patient-centered care

For practices who choose not to participate in Advanced Alternative Payment Models (APMs), CMS reimbursement rates will be determined by MIPS

Approximately **25%** of MIPS quality performance measures are directly impacted by medication management
